Jewelry Boxes of various types of wood that included Bubinga, Oak, Walnut, Cherry, Pecan, Butter Nut, Honduras Mahogany, Curly Maple, & Aussie Lacewood. Some of the Ducks were plain, & some were detailed & had some carving applied. He mentioned that he used a Die Grinder & some Pattern Maker Files #49, and #50 made by Nicholson to give the special ducks some detail & flow. His favorite finish is "Minwax antique Oil Finish, and the Ducks looked GREAT!! He also brought an Animated Ape, of Walnut that had wheels on his legs & arms that moved when pushed.
